


Profile Photos


DO

Story Photos




DO

- Use only clear photos with visible text
- Make sure your text does not overlap the app's functions
- Incorporate photos that bring awareness to your specialties (tarot cards, birth charts, candles, etc).
- Utilize photos that ask questions and start a conversation. This is the perfect way to get an interested user to interact with you in private.
- Use creative ways to bring awareness to the Messenger and Call features
- Keep your community informed by providing any quotes, tarot spreads, new tools, and/or astrological updates

DON'T

- Upload horizontal or landscape photos (they will appear awkward and hard to see). Same goes for images that are upside down
- Include text or images that go against our prohibited guidelines
- Use text that is hard to read make sure that interested members and users can understand and read the font clearly.
- Give out contact information or share personal information

DO

- Film and capture in 9:16 format Portrait style
 videos
- Use this opportunity to showcase your knowledge. Talk about your niche and passions. Highlight the new Full Moon and what it means for you, your go-to oracle cards, what crystals you use for healing broken hearts, etc.
- Provide value and entertainment. Show your new and old users why you are a specialists in this field
- Make sure your text and videos are in English

 be in another language)

DON'T

- Upload horizontal/landscape videos (they will appear awkward and hard to see)
- Include topics that go against our prohibited guidelines



Easy on the filters! While filters are a great way to spice up a photo or story, we recommend not using them to change your face.





When you combine your genuine personality and incredible talents, new and old members will notice!
